Campus Safety Statement on Scripps College "Halloween: Claremont after Dark" party

On October 29, 2022, at approximately 10:45 pm the Scripps College "Halloween: Claremont after Dark" party was shut down due to actions by party goers that resulted in unsafe conditions for students and staff. At no point in the shutting down of the event did any Campus Safety or CSC Security Guards use a fire extinguisher or any force to disperse the crowd. Vocal commands to leave the event utilizing a public address system were used to disperse the crowd. Immediately prior to the shutdown security guards witnessed students discharging a fire extinguisher.

The event was shut down at the direction of the Scripps College Student Affairs staff based on 200+ students forcing their way through the entry point all at one time, in addition to many students climbing over and/or pulling down event fencing.

All standard pre-planning protocols for this event were followed and the event was staffed with security guards based on the anticipated pre-set attendance via wristband distribution. All wristbands were distributed by Scripps Colleges' Scripps Associated Students prior to the event. Unfortunately, there were a number of students attempting to gain entry to the party without a wristband or with counterfeit wristbands. Then the behavior of the crowd--forcing their way through the entrance, climbing over and/or pulling down fencing created an unsafe situation that necessitated the shutting down of the party.
